1. Who is this conference for?

4. What is the last date to submit my abstract?

The last date for abstract submission is 28 December 2023.

5. What is the word limit for the abstract submission?

The word limit for the abstract is 150 words and the word limit for the title is 10 words.

6. Is the registration fee refundable?

Once paid, the registration fee is not refundable.

7. Where will the conference take place?

Presenters can choose to present their paper on-site at the International Mother Language Institute (IMLI) in Dhaka, while presenters from abroad can present online.

8. When will I be informed if my abstract has been accepted?

The notification of acceptance will be emailed between January 1-7, 2023.

9. What kinds of audio-visual tools can I use for my presentation?

Presenters can use slides, images, posters, and videos in their presentations.

10. Can more than one person present a paper?

Yes, 2-3 people can present a paper together. Each presenter must register for the conference separately using the link on the conference website.
